Meeting called to order by Bill Harris.

1. What should the league do with the increasing rates at the Jamestown Public Library for our equipment room? Bill Harris states that he and Kevin Hege have researched renting a storage facility at American Flag Storage at a cheaper rate than the library. The library currently charges \$187.50/month.
2. Website updates – The minutes have been added to the website. More updates will continue to be made to our website in the future. JSC will also post the minutes on their website.
3. Open position for the Director of JSC - Steve Diamond has been appointed as Director.
  - A. There will be a club wide curriculum.
  - B. JYL/JSC Bridge program for spring.
  - C. Invite rec for training w/ coaches and players.
4. Basketball updates –
  - A. Successful Season
  - B. The JES gym floor is in poor condition – hoping GCS will be repairing it by next season.
  - C. Free Throw parent/child contest was a success. Had 50 player/parent participants.
  - D. The board would like Kevin Hege to give a break down of referee fees/game. Also, baseball umpire fees/game.
5. The board would like Brent Steele and Kevin Archer to give a class to the board on the financials. There are a lot of questions on how to locate items.
6. Spring Soccer – numbers are good.
  - A. Down 65 players from Spring 10 to Spring 11.
7. Spring Baseball/Softball
  - A. Baseball registration will be held in March along with a Dick's Sporting Goods Night.
  - B. JYL has received the Chevy Promotion again this year.
8. JSC
  - A. Scott Behe states the he has an acquaintance that does lighting. He thinks it might cost the league about \$47,000 to light JSC. He is checking to how much it would cost to run the lines to the fields est. \$40,000 - \$50,000. Would like to see if Duke Energy or Pike Electric would donate that cost.

9. Baseball Lights – JYL is applying for a grant through the Town of Jamestown and must be completed prior to March 16<sup>th</sup>. You can apply for this grant money and you can ask for as much as you would like. It will take \$140,000 to fix the lights on the baseball field. Dennis Kimbrough would like the city to give feedback once the grant is given. Scott Behe asked if the league could attend the next city meeting. Lance Appelberg stated the problem with the lights is that the town broke them and now the lights need to be brought up to code in order to fix them.
10. Kevin Hege has worked out with Beyond the Box to have concessions a few times this season at the JAC fields.
11. By-Laws – Tom Grose, Chris Groh and Dennis Kimbrough got together to discuss updating the by-laws of the league. They discussed the following:
